A Regular meeting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, July 17th. 1936, at 10 o'clock a.m.
Present Commissioner Fraser, A. C. Bell, W. P. Philp, R. Bolton, C. B. Brown
L. Rimmer, Dr. Sager, F. J. Rundle.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of July 10th. be adopted as written

Superintendent, Vancouver & Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board. wrote requesting grant of Easement 80 feet wide through Lots 1 and 2, D.L. 74 south of Still Creek for the purpose of continuing present drainage ditch eastward from the boundary of D.L. 73.

Ordered: "That request for easement be granted."

Secretary of the North East Burnaby Farmers Institute wrote re horse riding on plank walk between Government and Sprout Sts., and requesting that same be prohibited.

Ordered: "That this matter be referred to the Superintendent, and that notices prohibiting horse riding be posted."

G. Latimer wrote complaining of drainage conditions at his property, Lot "A" Pt. Blk. 9, D.L. 126.

Ordered: "That this matter be referred to the Superintendent for report."

Superintendent submitted report on B. C. E. Ry. pole plan, as follows:
K-8800/1847 Proposed pole line on Lane south of Georgia Street between Alpha Avenue and Beta Avenue. Distance from property line to outside face of pole to be 1' 0" to conform with existing poles.,

and recommended that the location be approved.

The Committee will now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment.

The Burnaby Land Acquisition and Road Dedication By-law 1935 will now be read a Third time.

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Land Acquisition and Road Dedication By-law 1935 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk, and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

The requisitions were then examined.

Ordered: "That requisitions as submitted, be approved."

The sitting then adjourned.
