A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, October 23rd, 1935 at 10.00 a.m.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of October 16th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Ordered: "That the recommendations of the Treasurer be and are hereby adopted."

#### Board of Works Report:

Your Committee met on Friday, October 18th, 1935 and recommend:

1. That sidewalk on Delta Avenue be brushed out and that holes be filled in.
2. That Ellesmere Avenue, north of Dundas Street be improved.
3. That sidewalk on Kingsway between 15th and 16th Avenues be improved.
4. That the Shell Oil Company be advised that in our opinion the season is too far advanced to satisfactorily carry out the hard-surfacing of Kensington Avenue and that provision will be made in the 1936 estimates to carry out this work, and that in the meantime the Superintendent maintain the present roadway in as good condition as possible.

Ordered: "That the report of the Board of Works be and is hereby adopted."

Ordered: "That General accounts to October 19th, 1935 amounting to \$32,470.14; Relief accounts \$41,231.80 and Payrolls \$2,187.19 be approved for payment."

Ordered: "That the Commissioner do now sit as a committee of the whole to reconsider "Burnaby Unemployment Relief Loan By-law No. 5, 1935"

Ordered: "That the Committee do now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment."

Ordered: "That the "Burnaby Unemployment Relief Loan By-law No. 5, 1935" be now read a Thirdtime."

Ordered: "That the "Burnaby Unemployment Relief Loan By-law No. 5, 1935" do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Ordered: "That agreement between His Majesty the King, in the right of the Province of B.C. and the Corporation of the District of Burnaby providing for the loan of \$26,000.00 to cover Municipal proportion of Unemployment Relief costs up to the 30th September 1935 be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

The sitting then adjourned.
