

Wednesday - July 24th, 1935.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, July 24th, 1935 at 10.00 a.m.
Present: Commissioner H. M. Fraser; Messrs R. Bolton; C. B. Brown, P. J. Fussell, Dr. Wm. Sager, and A. McFee.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of July 17th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Mrs. A. Maxwell - complaining of the condition of Williams Street in the 3900 Block.

Ordered: "That this matter be referred to the Superintendent for report."

Mrs. C. McKinnon - requesting that the brush on boulevard of 3900 block Georgia Street be cut.

Ordered: "That this matter be referred to the Superintendent."

L. P. Long and others - requesting improvements to Silver Avenue from B.C.E.R. north to Kingsway.

Ordered: "That this application be referred to the Superintendent for report."

E. E. Walker - Sales Engineer - B.C.E.R. advising that the estimated cost of moving pole at intersection of Kingsway, Grange Street and Patterson Avenue is \$135.45 and that the Company is prepared to assume 50% of this cost. The Treasurer recommended that the Company be authorized to remove the pole at a total cost to this Corporation of \$62.50
