

Wednesday, October 30th, 1935.

A Regular Sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, October 30th, 1935 at 10 o'clock A.M.

Present: Commissioner H.M. Fraser, W.E. Philips, Assessor, F.J. Russell, School Board Secretary, Wm. Sager, Medical Health Officer, B. P. Scott, Superintendent, E.L. Rimmer, Relief Officer, R. Folton, Treasurer, A. C. Bell, Building Inspector, and C. B. Brown, Clerk.

Ordered: That the minutes of the meeting of October 23rd. instant be adopted as written and confirmed.

Superintendent wrote re Delinquent Tax By-law Contracts advising that 653 contracts had been signed to a value of \$36,876.00, of which 389 have been completed - value \$19,402.13.

Ordered: That this communication be received and filed.

5. That application of D.C. McKinnon to lease Lot 2, Blk. 1, D.L. 59/136/137 for a term of three years at an annual rental of \$37.00 be granted, subject to the Lessee being required to perform work to the value of \$50.00 per annum on the said property as additional rent.
