

Wednesday - July 31st, 1935.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, July 31st, 1935 at 10.20 a.m.

Present: Commissioner Fraser:

Messrs C.B.Brown, R.Bolton, F.J.Russell; W.P.Philps; Dr.Wm.Sager and A.C.Bell.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of July 24th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

W.Loat - drawing attention to condition of bridge over Eagle Creek at Piper Avenue and suggesting that repairs be carried out forthwith.

The Treasurer advised that the Superintendent had the matter in hand.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and Mr.Loat be advised that this matter will receive attention."

Dr.J.W.McIntosh - M.H.O. City of Vancouver - requesting information as to what progress is being made in matter of providing access to the Vancouver City cemetery.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and the Superintendent be requested to submit report as to present situation."

F.L.Snowball - drawing attention to the lowness of the water in Burnaby Lake and complaining of odours arising from the mud flats thus exposed.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and Mr.Snowball be advised that the lake comes under the jurisdiction of the Sewerage Board and that his complaint will be forwarded to the Commissioner Mr.Cleveland."

J.Mackay - requesting that if it is not the intention of the Corporation to proceed with paving of Burris Street to Douglas Road, that steps be taken to improve the condition of the existing roadway.

Ordered: "That this letter be referred to the Superintendent."

The Building Inspector submitted a recommendation that the provisions of the Burnaby Town Planning By-law 1927 be waived to permit of the erection and use of a combined dwelling and store on Lot 20, Blocks 27/28, D.L.98.

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Building Inspector be and is hereby adopted."

The Superintendent submitted recommendation that B.C.E.R. pole Plan.K.8800/1852 covering proposed pole line on Rosser Avenue, between McGill Street and lane south of McGill Street; and on lane south of McGill Street and West of Rosser Avenue. Distance from property line on Rosser Avenue to be 10'6" and on lane 1'0" to conform to existing poles on lane east of Rosser Avenue

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Superintendent be adopted."

The Assessor and Property salesman submitted report on application of S.H. Fong to purchase Lots 3 and 4, Block 2, D.L.122 for the sum of \$150.00 - \$50.00 cash balance in 3 years and recommended that the application be not entertained.

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Assessor and Property Salesman be adopted."

The Assessor and Property Salesman submitted report on application of Rev. G.M.Trainor to purchase Lot 54A S.D. 1 & 2, Blk.5. D.L.74.S 1/2 for the sum of \$60.00 cash, and recommended that the offer be accepted.

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Assessor and Property Salesman be adopted."

Ordered: "That the B.C.E.R. Coy. be requested to notify this Corporation in all cases when existing poles are being replaced."

Ordered: "That the requisitions as submitted be approved."
