G. Monk, Secretary-Treasurer, Burnaby Fire Fighters Association, Local 323, wrote requesting a meeting with the committee of the Council within the next ten days. Moved by Cr. Hatherly, Seconded by Cr. Dingle: "That the letter be received and meeting be arranged as soon as possible.

Carried unanimously.

Irene Cairns wrote requesting that the street lights be lit up to 2:00 A.M. Moved by Cr. Lewis, Seconded by Cr. Hatherly: That the letter be received and that the B.C.E.R. be instructed to have street lights lit from 5 a.m. to dawn, and from dusk to 2 a.m. until further orders.

Carried unanimously.

D. J. McIntosh wrote on behalf of the Renfrew United Sunday School expressing appreciatentor the use of Eurnaby Park for their annual picnic Moved by Cr. Hatherly, Seconded by Cr. Wilson: "That the letter be received and acknowledgement be made to the Parkkeeper.

Carried unanimously.

Secretary, Burneby Town Planning Commission, wrote submitting the following resolution passed by their Commission.

"That the Municipal Council be requested to consider the re-contouring of the southern slope as a Post war rehabilitation project and that it be a further recommendation that the Council proceed to complete the plans for such recontouring.
