A meeting of the Adjourned Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, May 1st, 1944 at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Reeve Willson in the Chair, Crs. Wilson, Dingle, Beamish, Morrsion, Gartlan, Lewis and Ball.

The Council met as a Committee of the Whole on Monday, April 24th, 1944 at 9:15 p.m. Councillor Lewis absent, and recommend:

- That where the term "any one year" appears in the agreement between the Corporation and the Civic Employees Union it shall be construed to mean one calander year from January 1st to December 31st inclusive
- That no employee shall be entitled to receive sick pay in any one year until he has worked at least five days in such year. .2.
- That no employee shall be entitled to receive pay for Statutory Holidays until he has worked at least five days in such year. That all employees engaged in outside employment be employed on a forty hour per week basis, and that that rate of pay be adjusted so that the said employee will receive for the 40 hour week the same total as presently received for a 44 hour week.
- That where Caretakers at Burnaby Park and Central Park are required to work on Saturday afternoons and Sundays adjustment be made in the subsequent week.
- Subsequent week.
 That cost of living bonus for all employees earning less than
 \$2100.00 per annum be increased to \$8.00 per month, and that cost of
 living bonus of \$5.00 per month be paid to all employees earning from
 \$2100.00 to \$3000.00 Changes in Cost of Living Bonus to be effective as from May 1st, 1944.

 That salary of R. D. Etches, Clerk, Engineering Department be increased to \$160.00 per month retroactive to January 1st, 1944 1 6.
