- That the cost of living bonus for all employees earning less than \$2,100,00 per annum be increased to \$8.00 per month, and that cost of living bonus of \$5.00 per month be paid to all employees earning from \$2,100.00 to \$5,000.00 changes in cost of living bonus to be effective as from May 1st, 1944.
