District Engineer, Department of Public Works, wrote advising of the arrangement made whereby the cost of maintaining the Brunette Bridge #4 is divided - 1/8 of the cost against Coquitlam and $\frac{1}{4}$ y of the cost against Burnaby Moved by Cr. Mr. Watsen addressed the Council and requested recensideration of the decision to rent preperty of Blocks 15,16 & 21, D.L. 151B for \$14,50 per acre per year and suggesting that the present sum of \$7.00 per acre would be a fair rental.
