Keel, Deputy Treasurer; (3) That Richard Bolton be and is hereby authorized for and on behalf of the Corporation from time to time to receive from the said Bank a statement of the Account of the Corporation together with all relative vouchers and all unpaid bills lodged for collection by the Corporation and all items returned unpaid and charged to the account of the Corporation and to sign and deliver to the said Bank the Bank's form of verification, settlement of balance and release (4) That this resolution be communicated to the said Bank and remain in force until written notice to the contrary shall have been given to the Manager for the time being of the Branch of the said Bank at which the account of the Corporation is kept and receipt of such notice duly acknowledged in writing."
