

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

The Council met as a Committee of the Whole on Monday, January 8th, 1945 at 10:15 p.m.

Present: Reeve Morrison in the Chair, Councillors West, Philips, Beamish, Wilson, Gartlan, Lewis and Ball.

Letter from Basil Newbury requesting that his appointment as Assessor be cancelled, was read.

Moved by Cr. Ball, Seconded by Cr. Wilson: "That the position of Assessor be "Boarded."

Carried - Cr. Beamish against.

Moved by Cr. Ball, Seconded by Cr. Gartlan: "That the position of Assessor be boarded from now until noon on Monday, January 15th, 1945."

Carried - Cr. Beamish against.

Moved by Cr. Ball, Seconded by Cr. Gartlan: "That His Worship the Reeve in cooperation with the Chairmen of the various Committees and the Heads of Departments discuss the re-organization of the Administrative staff."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Lewis, Seconded by Cr. Philips: "That this Council sitting in Committee of the Whole recommend to the Council that Mr. R. Bolton, Collector-Treasurer, be granted two months leave of absence with pay."

After discussion and vote on the motion being called for, Cr. Lewis withdrew his motion - Cr. Philips declining to withdraw his seconding of the motion.
