

Monday - November 18th, 1946

A regular meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, November 18th, 1946 at 7:35 p.m.

Present: Feeve Morrison in the Chair, Crs. West, Philps, Reamish, Gartlan, MacSorley and Ball.

Moved by Cr. Philps, Seconded by Cr. Ball: "That the Minutes of the previous meeting be adopted as written and confirmed."

Carried Unanimously.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Secretary, Burnaby School Board, wrote advising that they had been authorized by the Council of Public Instruction and the Assistant Superintendent of Education submit a referendum to the Burnaby electors at the December elections for the spending of \$1,200.00 for the establishment of kindergarten schools in Burnaby Moved by Cr. Beamish, Seconded by Cr. MacSorley: "That the letter be received and filed and the Clerk be instructed to bring down a referendum to the electors as requested."
