

Tuesday, - June 10th, 1947

An Adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Tuesday, June 10th, 1947 at 1:17 p.m.

Present: Reeve Morrison in the Chair, Crs. West, Beamish, Green, Cartlan, MacSorley and Ball

Reeve Morrison submitted recommendation that the salaries of the undermentioned members of the Municipal Hall Staff be increased as shown:-

1. D. Whelan, Asst. Engineer, from \$180.00 to \$220.00 per month effective June 1st, 1947.
2. Mrs. J. Waddington, Addressograph Operator - from \$120.00 to \$150.00 per month effective as from May 1st, 1947
