Present: Reeve Morrison, Crs. West, Philips, Beamish, Green, Gartlan, MacSorley and Ball.

FIREMEN'S CONCILIATION COMMITTEE REPORT.

Your Committee met on Monday, May 5th, 1947 and recommend:-

1. That wages of Firefighters other than officers be increased by \$5.00 per month, retroactive to January 1st, 1947.
2. That wages of all officers of the Fire Department be increased by \$7.50 per month, retroactive to January 1st, 1947

Moved by Cr. Philips, Seconded by Cr. Ball: "That the recommendations of the Committee be concurred in."

Carried Unanimously.

COUNCIL CONCILIATION COMMITTEE REPORT.
