That by reason of the Award by School Arbitration Board, increasing school costs, which predicated a four mill increase in the tax rate and, knowing such an increase in mill rate would be disastrous to the econemy of the Corporation, the Council has no option but to reduce drastically the Annual Municipal Estimates to a figure to keep within the present tax rate of 55 mills. Therefore, be it a recommendation that all Jepartment Heads be instructed to keep
- their respective expenditures within the reduced amounts alloted to their respective Jepartments.

  6. That Mr. A. S. Duncan, of New Westminster, be appointed as Council representative to the Conciliation Board, in the matter of the dispute between (1) The Corperation of Burnaby and the Burnaby Fire Fighters' Association, and (2) The Corporation of Burnaby and the Civic Employees' Union Local 23.
- 7. That Counciller Philps be delegated to present the cases to the Conciliation Board both for Fireman and Civic Employees.
