

Monday - April 26th 1948

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall, Eimonds on Monday, April 26th 1948 at 9:35 A.M.

Present: Reeve Morrison in the Chair, Crs. West, Philps, Beamish, MacSorley, Gartlan, McLean and Drummond.

Chief Executive Officer, Labour Relations Board wrote advising that Mr. S. Willisroft has been appointed conciliation officer to discuss matter of wages agreements between the Corporation and Burnaby Civic Employees' Union and between the Corporation and Burnaby Fire Fighters' Association

Moved by Cr. Beamish, Seconded by Cr. MacSorley: "That the letters be received."

Carried Unanimously

Special Committee appointed to consider the application of the B.C. Electric Ry. Co. to acquire certain properties for route of a proposed transmission line submitted recommendation that their offer as contained in their letter of March 19th be accepted and that easements be granted over certain of the parcels which the Company did not wish to purchase outright, and further, that the Clerk take steps to make application under the Plans Cancellation Act to cancel plan of Blocks "C", "D", "E" and "H", J.L. 90 and also to bring down a Closing By-law to close the road allowance west of Douglas Road and make application to have the title of the said road so cancelled vested in the name of the adjoining owners.

Committee also reported on application of J. Kunferman to purchase property on the Central Arterial Highway pointing out that the possibility of servicing property in this vicinity with water was very remote, and recommending that no property on the Central Arterial Highway not served with water mains be sold.

Moved by Cr. West, Seconded by Cr. Philps: "That the recommendations of the Committee be adopted."

Carried Unanimously


