An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds on Monday, May 21st 1951 at 7:35 P.M.

Moved by Cr. Wilks, Seconded by Cr. Philps: "That a letter of condolence be forwarded to Mr. W. T. Willson on the passing of his late wife."

His Worship, Reeve Beamish submitted report advising of a Committee of the Whole meeting held May 14th 1951, when discussions took place with regard to action to be taken as a result of evidence presented at the recent court hearings on the Charge laid against our former Assistant Sanitary Inspector, and which involved others of the Employees, and advising the matter had been considered from all angles, with the result that a severe reprimand had been issued to the employees involved, and a stern warning had been issued to all employees of the Municipal staff, that conduct of this nature by any employee or group of employees would not be condoned in any way whatsoever, and would carry a penalty of immediate dismissal.
