

Monday, October 22, 1951.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, on Monday, October 22, 1951, at 7:30 P.M.

Present: Reeve Beamish in the Chair, Councillors Armstrong, Charlton, Isherwood, MacSorley, Philips, Sargent and Wilks.

A communication was received from the B. C. Motor Transportation Limited enclosing a copy of an application and letter sent to the Motor Carrier Branch of the Public Utilities Commission in which a request for revision of Pacific Stage Line fares on all routes with the exception of the Vancouver-Seattle route and the Vancouver-Horseshoe Bay route was made.

Moved by Councillor Isherwood and seconded by Councillor MacSorley "That the correspondence be received and that any increase in fares at the present time in respect to the Transportation Company's system effecting the Municipality of Burnaby be opposed."

Moved by Councillor Isherwood and seconded by Councillor Sargent "That "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 13, 1951" be now reconsidered."

Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Councillor Isherwood and seconded by Councillor Sargent "That "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 13, 1951" be now finally adopted, signed by the Reeve and the Clerk and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."
