Moved by Councillor Philps and seconded by Councillor Wilks "That "Burnaby District Improvement By-law No. 3, 1953, Ameniment By-law 1953" be now finally adopted, that it be signed by the Reeve and Clerk and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Moved by Councillor Philps and seconded by Councillor Armstrong "That the Clerk be instructed to prepare the following resolutions for the U.B.C.M. Convention:

Resolution recommending the abolition of the Sheer Protection Act.
 Resolution recommending amendment to Subsection 9, Section 58 of the Municipal Act to provide for a division of the renumeration paid to Municipal elected representatives into expense allowance and other.
 Moved by Councillor Isherwood and seconded by Councillor Armstrong "That the Clerk be instructed to write the Executive Director of the Union of B.C. Municipalities with regard to the assessment of improvements as defined in the Municipal Act."
