An adjourned meeting of the Municipal Council was held at the Municipal Hall, 1930 Kingsway, on Monday, March 1st, 1954 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: Reeve MacSorley in the Chair; Crs. W.P.Philps, Wilks, Charlton, Hughes, Hean, Morrison and F.Philps.

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE AS A WHOLE.

Your Committee met on February 26th and recommend:

- (1) That an architect be engaged to prepare plans for remodelling the Municipal Hall and to provide for the addition of two wings at an approximate cost of \$225,000.00.
- (2) That His Worship, the Reeve, Councillors W.P.Philps and WM.Morrison with the Treasurer and Building Inspector be a Committee to select the architect and to confer with him in the preparation of plans.
- (3) That the site for the New Municipal Yard in the vicinity of Laurel Street and Norland Avenue be approved.
- (4) That Councillor Hean be delegated to inquire into the cost of engaging a full time Municipal Solicitor.
- (5) That the inquiry into kindergarten operation be discontinued.
- (6) That the action of the Building Inspector in ^{refusing} ~~refusing~~ to issue Building permits for prefabricated houses manufactured by the Bau-Export G.M.B.H. Hamburg Tübingen Karl Kubler A.G. Stuttgart Goppingen, Manufacturers be confirmed.
