JANUARY 19, 1959

A Regular meeting of the Municipal Council was held in the Council Chambers, Municipal Hall, 4545 East Grandview-Douglas Highway, Burnaby, on Monday, January 19, 1959 at 7:30 p.m.

Reeve Emmott in the Chair: Councillors Mather, McLean, Seifner, MacSorley, Jamieson, Brown, Edwards, and Prittle.

Reverend D. More led in Opening Prayer.

Moved by Councillor Jamieson, Seconded by Councillor McLean: "That the minutes of the previous meeting be adopted as circulated."

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Central Burnaby Ratepayers' & Citizens' Association requesting that the Silver Cup Trophy donated by the Municipal Council in 1950 for the annual debating contest between the students of Burnaby North and Burnaby South High Schools, be given for permanent custody to the Burnaby North High School, inasmuch as they have won this debate contest eight consecutive times. It was further requested that a new trophy be provided for annual debating contest commencing with the current year, between the Burnaby North, Burnaby South and Burnaby Central High Schools.

Moved by Councillor Brown, Seconded by Councillor Prittie: "That the request of the Central Burnaby Ratepayers! & Citizens! Association for the donation of a new trophy be acceded to."

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Burnaby Public Library presented the 1958 Annual Report of the Public Library

1. Sussex - Grange and McKercher Intersection.

Recommending that Stop Signs be installed at the South-East and North-West corners of Sussex and Grange. Further that the signs be accompanied by advance warning signs: "Stop Ahead" for a temporary period of 30 days. It was further recommended that every effort be made to have a view obstruction removed at this intersection.

TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE -- REPORT NO. 1, 1959 (CONTINUED)

3. School Crosswalk -- Cariboo Road and Armstrong Avenue.

The Committee recommended:

- (a) That a school crossing be installed on Cariboo Road at the North crosswalk of Armstrong.
- (b) That the North crosswalk of Armstrong be painted.
- That advance warning signs: "Crosswalk (with a directional arrow)" be installed.
- (d) That pavement markings be painted as soon after the installation of a crosswalk as possible and that the above recommendations be dependent and subsequent to the construction of a sidewalk, asphalt walk, or footpath on the East side of Cariboo Road between Holmes and the North crosswalk of Armstrong.
- (e) That a School Boy Patrol be organized to provide additional help for the children of the smaller grades from Armstrong School.

Moved by Councillor Prittie, Seconded by Councillor Mather: "That this matter be referred to the Municipal Manager for investigation and report."

Parking restriction -- South side Hastings East of Gilmore.

- A "No Parking" zone be created on the South side of Hastings Street from the East line of Gilmore Avenue to 100 feet east of the east line of Gilmore Avenue.
- That a bus zone be created from 100 feet east of the east line of Gilmore Avenue to 200 feet east of the east line of Gilmore Avenue.

Having regard to the opinion of the Municipal Engineer on what would be acceptable from a construction viewpoint and the cost involved which would be in excess of \$10,000.00 to Burnaby, it is considered that this sum of money should not be made available for this work while there are so many urgent requirements for road improvements in this Municipality.
