# NOVEMBER 10, 1963

An Adjourned meeting of the Municipal Council was held in the Council Chambers, Municipal Hall, 4545 East Grandview-Douglas Highway, on Monday, November 18, 1963 at 7:30 p.m.

PRESENT:

Reeve Emmott in the Chair; Councillors Blair, Cafferky, Clark, Drummond, Harper, Kalyk, MacSorley and Wells

MOVED BY COUNCILLOR CAFFERKY, SECONDED BY COUNCILLOR BLAIR: "That all of the below listed correspondence be received."

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

Recording Secretary, Burnaby Fire Fighters Association, wrote requesting permission to hold a Tag Day for the Muscular Dystrophy Association of Canada on November 29th and 30th, 1963.

MOVED BY COUNCILLOR MacSORLEY, SECONDED BY COUNCILLOR HARPER: "That permission be granted to the Association to conduct its campaign on the dates mentioned."

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

City Clerk, Corporation of the City of New Westminster. submitted a letter advising that his Council was willing to send a representative to a proposed meeting to obtain further details in connection with the formation of an Association of Lower Mainland Municipalities.

Mrs. W. H. D. Fairbank submitted a letter urging that Council consider the provision of a sidewalk on the east side of Langley Street between 10th Avenue and Armstrong Avenue.

The liaison with the Engineering Department, Councillor E. Cafferky, reported verbally that the Engineering Department would be sending a letter to each owner on the subject portion of Langley Street asking that they signify their wish as to whether they would prefer a sidewalk or a concrete curb.

MOVED BY COUNCILLOR CAFFERKY, SECONDED BY COUNCILLOR BLAIR: "That the action proposed by the Engineering Department in connection with the matter under discussion be approved."

The Honourable George J. McIlraith, Minister of Transport for Canada, submitted a letter enclosing a copy of one addressed to the City of North Vancouver dealing with the matter of improved harbour facilities on the North Shore of Vancouver Harbour.

Business Agent, Division 134, Amalgamated Association of Street, Electric Railway and Motor Coach Employees of America, submitted a letter advising that the B. C. Hydro and Power Authority proposes to reduce transit service on Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day on all lines in Curnaby except for the inter-city service on Kingsway.

The Association asked that Council protest the proposed service cuts on the ground that they are not fair to the people who have no other means of transportation.

MOVED BY COUNCILLOR CLARK, SECONDED BY COUNCILLOR MacSORLEY: "That the B. C. Hydro and Power Authority be asked to confirm whether it plans to implement the service reductions mentioned in the letter from the Association."

MOVED BY COUNCILLOR KALYK, SECONDED BY COUNCILLOR DRUMMOND: "That, in the event the Authority confirms the information received from the Association, an invitation be extended to it and the Amalgamated Association to be present at the next meeting of Council for the purpose of explaining their respective points of view on the subject matter."

<u>Vice-President</u>, <u>Seventh Day Adventist Reform Movement</u>, wrote requesting permission to solicit in the Municipality during the month of December.

"That the Movement be asked to furnish details as to the nature of its proposed ingathering campaign and it also be suggested that a representative from the Movement be present at the next meeting of Council to explain the purpose of the campaign."

The matter of purchasing two Conveyors and one Screen was then lifted from the table.

Municipal Engineer reported verbally that he had further investigated the matter of possibly purchasing the equipment in question from a source other than Purvis-Ritchie Co. Ltd. and Engelland Bros. and, as a result, he had found that the two Conveyors would cost approximately \$4,300.00 each if purchased from any other company. He added that it was not possible to locate another screen of the type needed but it was possible that the Municipality could construct one in its shop at a cest of between \$700.00 and \$800.00.

He pointed out that the total cost would therefore be

approximately \$9,000.00 as opposed to the \$2,500.00 cited in the report of the Municipal Manager last week.

The Municipal Engineer also stated that he felt the inviting of tenders for the purchase of the equipment in question would not result in a better opportunity than is currently before the Corporation.

MOVED BY COUNCILLOR HARPER, SECONDED BY COUNCILLOR CAFFERKY: "That authority be granted to purchase two Conveyors and one Screen from Purvis-Ritchie Co. Ltd. and Engelland Bros., respectively, at a total cost of \$2,500.00, with this sum to be chargeable against the Rotary Fund."
