REPORT OF THE POLICY COMMITTEE

Your Committee met on Monday, July 20th and dealt with the following matters:

1. Recognition of Services of Past Approving Officer

As Council is aware, the Municipal Assessor, Mr. L. H. Greensword, served as the Approving Officer for the Corporation between June 10th, 1963 and April 27th, 1964.

At a meeting on April 27, 1964, Council directed the Municipal Manager to discuss the matter of remuneration for Mr. Greensword during the term of his service as Approving Officer.

Your Committee dealt with this matter on July 20th and would recommend that Mr. Greensword be paid the sum of \$50 per month for each of the 10½ months he served as Approving Officer.

2. Industrial Edition of the Columbian Newspaper

Your Committee was informed that arrangements were made for the Corporation to participate in inserting an advertisement in an Industrial Edition of the Columbian that is to be published on August 5, 1964.

The cost to the Corporation of this advertisement will be \$227.00.

Your Committee would recommend that the action taken to arrange for the advertisement be ratified.
