An informal meeting of the Municipal Council was held in the Burnaby Municipal Hall at 8:55 p.m., January 3rd, 1966 to consider the reappointment of Messrs. James A. Barrington and A. B. Stewart to the Burnaby Parks and Recreation Commission.

PRESENT:

The Reeve explained that there had been an amendment to the Burnaby Parks Commission By-law 1957, passed in 1965, which provided that appointments to the Parks and Recreation Commission should be made at the first meeting of the Council in January each year and that the term of office of Commissioners Barrington and Stewart had expired immediately prior to the Inaugural meeting held this date, rather than on the 31st day of January, 1966.

MOVED BY COUNCILLOR CAFFERKY, SECONDED BY COUNCILLOR McLEAN: "That a recommendation go forward to the next regular meeting of the Municipal Council that Messrs. James A. Barrington and A. B. Stewart be reappointed to the Burnaby Parks and Recreation Commission effective January 3rd, 1966 for a two year term."
