GENTLEMEN:

Re: PARADE FLOAT

1. The Burnaby Junior Chamber of Commerce has agreed to assist the Municipality in regard to the proposed 1966 Parade Float being entered in the following

Parades:

Seattle Seafair Parade	-	July 30th
Kelowna Regatta Parade	-	August 10th
P.N.E. Parade	-	August 20th
Grey Cup Parade	-	November 25th.

2. The Burnaby Junior Chamber of Commerce will be responsible for:

(a) Transportation and accommodation of individuals to assure:

- (i) Proper entry of the float in the various parades;  
(ii) Manning and operating the float during the parades;

(b) Transportation, accommodation and chaperone for Miss Burnaby and attendants, where feasible, to add to the impression of the Float.

(c) Payment of expenses incidental to the proper representation of the float, e.g. flowers, hair arrangements for the girls, et cetera.

(d) Care of the float at the Parade district.

3. The Corporation is to be responsible for:

(a) Transportation for the float to and from the parade sites.

(b) Storage between parades.

(c) Maintenance.

(d) Insurance.

(e) Providing motive power.

4. The estimated costs for the Project are as follows:

(a) Production of float	-	\$ 3,000.00
(b) Expenses - Burnaby Junior Chamber of Commerce-		1,000.00
(c) Maintenance and renovation of float including operating personnel for the above mentioned parades -		500.00
(d) Transportation to and from the above mentioned parades, rent of motive power, insurance, et cetera		1,300.00
(e) Storage - Civil Defence Garage-7272 Kingsway		<u>N/C</u>
		<u>\$ 5,800.00</u>

It is recommended that the above arrangements be confirmed and that a Budget of \$5,800.00 be approved.
