Gentlemen:


Your Grants and Publicity Committee has met to consider various applications for financial assistance and reports as follows:

- SALVATION ARMY - It is recommended that a donation in the amount of \$1,500.00 be made to cover the work of this Organization.
- JOHN HOWARD SOCIETY OF BRITISH COLUMBIA - The activities of this Organization in respect of people released from penal institutions is well known and it is recommended that a donation of \$1,500.00 be approved.
- KIWANIS MUSIC FESTIVAL - The Festival provides a stimulus for many young Burnaby artists and it is felt that a donation of \$250.00 would be justified.
- GREATER VANCOUVER VISITORS AND CONVENTION BUREAU - The many promotional efforts of the Bureau in bringing tourists to the area justifies a grant in the amount of \$8,500.00.
- B.C. SOCIETY FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS. - It is recommended that the sum of \$200.00 be donated.
- CLEF SOCIETY OF BURNABY - The Society has done much over the years to support young Burnaby musicians and it is recommended that a donation of \$500.00 be made.
- CANADIAN PARAPLEGIC ASSOCIATION - The performance of the Association has been very creditable and a donation of \$1,000.00 is recommended.
- VANCOUVER LADIES' PIPE BAND - A request in the amount of \$500.00 has been received to help underwrite the annual festival of piping, drumming and dancing. This sum is recommended.
- AIR POLLUTION CONTROL SOCIETY- The Society requests an amount of \$300.00 to assist in their activities and it is so recommended.
- MODEL AERONAUTICS ASSOCIATION- OF CANADA(B.C. Zone) Two members from Burnaby, Mr. E. Avory and Mr. J. Tarvin will be competing in the World Championships in Prague, Czechoslovakia in August of this year. It is recommended that a grant in the amount of \$150.00 be made to help underwrite the expenses of participation.
- BURNABY SAFETY COUNCIL - The Council has been successful in fostering an awareness of safety measures throughout the Municipality and it is recommended that the usual grant of \$600.00 be made.

- BURNABY 5-PIN BOWLING ASSOCIATION - A Burnaby Team is proceeding to Winnipeg to compete the Western Canada Championships - March 23rd to 26th inclusive. There will be 14 bowlers in all and it is recommended that a grant of \$100.00 similar to that of 1964 be made.
- BIG BROTHERS OF B.C. - It is recommended that a grant of \$1,000.00 similar to that of 1966 be made to assist in the valuable work of this organization.
