Re: 1938 Assessment Roll

The following table indicates the totals obtained in the 1938 Assessment Roll and compares them with the 1987 totals.

The amount of the increases has been influenced by three factors - the change in real estate market values, the adoption of the Two Value System, and the value of new construction. The upward trend of the real estate market in the last year or two has increased practically all values of least 5%. This increase was added to the great majority of assessments for School Purposes and additional increases ranging up to 300% were applied to General Purpose Assessments are not artificially limited to increases of 5%.

New Construction to a value of 921,634,600 was added to the Roll this year.
