RECOMMENDATION:

THAT this report be received for information purposes.

REPORT

R.C.M.P. personnel made personal contact with the complainant, and with residents of the area under review, to record first-hand details concerning the reported noise complaints. We were able to identify some individuals who contributed toward unnecessary noise and have taken action.

All calls for assistance to the R.C.M.P. in the past had been individually responded to, however, in some instances the parties apparently responsible had left the area, which prevented establishing identity. We will continue to respond to calls and, as time allows, preventive patrols will be directed into the area with a view of curbing disturbances.

In conclusion, it must be appreciated this being a recreation area frequented by large numbers of people, particularly during warm weather, often spontaneous reaction on site during arrival or departure prevents curbing this type of problem entirely regardless of patrols, which can only devote a given percentage of time to any one area of the Municipality.
