REPORT

The Community Heritage Commission, at its meeting held on 2007 April 05, received a verbal report regarding the City of Burnaby Award for the 2007 "Rivers to Sea Regional Historica Fair", which is to be held at the Burnaby Village Museum on 2007 May 4 – 5.

In 2005, the City of Burnaby through the aegis of Burnaby Village Museum was selected as the Historica representative for the "Lower Mainland North" region. The Community Heritage Commission has created and funded the City of Burnaby community award to recognize the best student project with a Burnaby heritage or history theme to participate with this regional Historica Fair. Awarding of a community award in the name of the City will encourage more students to explore and learn about Burnaby's heritage and contribute to this valuable educational endeavour.

The cost of engraving an ongoing City of Burnaby presentation award and purchasing an engraving an individual "keeper" plaque for the 2007 "Rivers to Sea Regional Historica Fair" is estimated at \$500.00 and is available in the Commission's 2007 annual budget.

Arising from discussion, the Community Heritage Commission requested that Council approve \$500.00 to fund the City of Burnaby Award.
