2014 Outstanding Citizen of the Year

The Executive Committee of Council is recommending Ms. Elsie Dean as the 2014 Outstanding Citizen of the Year and recipient of the Kushiro Cup Award. Ms. Dean was selected for her dedication, passion, indomitable spirit and drive to improve the lives of Burnaby citizens.

Growing up during the depression and WWII taught Ms. Dean exactly how to be happy with very little, learning to be resourceful, the benefits of hard work and perseverance established the foundation for understanding the importance of community. These traits were learned at a young age and have been exemplified throughout her life. With her war background and knowledge of the military, she first raised awareness of humanitarian rights and the need to preserve the peace. Ms. Dean started a group promoting a dialogue on the effects of war on local communities and was instrumental in Council passing a motion to make Burnaby a nuclear free zone.
