SUBJECT: 2020 LICENCE, IMPOUNDMENT AND MAINTENANCE FEES FOR DOGS

PURPOSE: To obtain Council approval for proposed 2020 licence, impoundment and maintenance fees for dogs.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** Council authorize the City Solicitor to bring forward an amendment to the Burnaby Animal Control Bylaw 1991, to provide for an increase in the licence, impoundment and maintenance fees for dogs as outlined in this report, effective 2020 January 01.

REPORT

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Fees for Burnaby dog licences, impoundments and maintenance are contained in the Burnaby Animal Control Bylaw 1991 and have been established to offset the costs of providing animal control services. The Burnaby dog licence, impoundment and maintenance fees were last revised in 2015.

Dog licence renewal notifications are mailed out to all dog owners that have current licenses in November of each year and owners that pay before March 1st are provided a discount rate.

2.0 POLICY SECTION

The recommended action is aligned with the City of Burnaby's Corporate Strategic Plan by supporting the following goals and sub-goals of the plan:

3.0 DOG LICENCE, IMPOUNDMENT AND MAINTENANCE FEES

Staff are recommending for 2020, a fee increase based on compounded Consumer Price Index (CPI) changes over the previous four years:

- 2016 - 2.2%
- 2017 - 2.2%
- 2018 - 2.9%
- 2019 - 2.2% (projected)

The proposed fees are rounded up to the nearest \$1, and will be amended in the Burnaby Animal Control Bylaw 1991 as follows:

Comparative animal fees from other cities are found in Attachment 1. This data shows that Burnaby's proposed dog licence fees remain lower than the regional average. If Council is in support of the fee increases contained within this report it is recommended that Council give first, second, and third readings of the amended Burnaby Animal Control Bylaw 1991 at the 2019 October 07 Council meeting to allow for billing of the new 2020 fees on 2019 December 01.

4.0 RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council authorize the City Solicitor to bring forward an amendment to the Burnaby Animal Control Bylaw 1991 to provide for an increase in the dog licence fees, as outlined in this report, effective 2020 January 01. Copies of the amendment bylaw appear elsewhere on this Council agenda. Subject to Council approval, first, second and third readings of the amendment bylaw at this meeting and then final adoption at the 2019 October 28 Council meeting would allow for billing of the new 2020 fees to be sent in November 2019.
