The City of Burnaby Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department, in conjunction with a large contingent of volunteer residents, are planning to hold a community picnic at Alta Vista Park. This annual event is intended to build and maintain community spirit and provide an informal opportunity for fun. Residents of all ages from the immediate neighbourhood are able to enjoy a variety of family activities while meeting and socializing with their neighbours.

This event requires the closure of a portion of the 5100 block of McKee St (see attached map) between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm. As this is a City event, liability insurance is not required.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the road closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as organizer.
- 2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.
- 3. That the barricades be attended during the closure.

4. That all directly affected residents be notified by the organizers at least 2 weeks in advance.


