### REPORT

#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

For over 20 years, the Burnaby Arts Council has used the City owned building at 6584 Deer Lake Avenue as their society office and program space and to operate the Deer Lake Gallery. Use of this building on Deer Lake Avenue was formalized in 2005 with a standard licence agreement which allows the society use of the building, along with custodial, gardening, maintenance, and utility support provided by the City, valued at approximately \$33,000 annually. This is provided in addition to the annual operating assistance of \$25,000 received from the City.

The support for the Burnaby Arts Council ensures the continuance of a healthy relationship between the City and community-driven arts that has existed for 50 years. The Arts Council supports the development of Burnaby based arts and artists as a hub of information and resources. They promote the arts through a community-based gallery and a wide array of accessible arts events.

Under the licence agreement, the City maintains responsibility for capital improvements to the house.

It is recommended that approval be given for a new licence agreement with the Burnaby Arts Council, as outlined in this report.

- 1. The new term for the licence will be for three (3) years commencing on 2021 January 01 and ending on 2023 December 31.
- 2. The Burnaby Arts Council shall pay to the City as a licence fee, the sum of \$1.00 per year in advance on the first day of each and every year during the term.
- 3. Insurance and indemnity requirements will comply with updated City standards.
