3.0 BACKGROUND

City Council, at its meeting held on 2019 October 28, adopted a report seeking approval to appoint members of Council and resident representatives to various Boards, Committees and Commissions for 2020. Arising from discussion of the report, Council amended the Social Planning Committee's Terms of Reference, Section 3.2 – Membership, to include up to three non-voting advisory groups, as recommended by staff.

Staff are recommending that the following representatives be considered as non-voting advisory members of the Committee:

- one representative of Fraser Health Authority Burnaby Hospital and Community Health Services; and
- two representatives from the Burnaby Inter-Agency Council, an umbrella organization comprised of representatives of the community social service provider sector.

4.0 RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council appoint Fraser Health Authority and the Burnaby Inter-Agency Council as non-voting advisory members to the Social Planning Committee, as outlined in Section 3.0 of the report. Pending Council's approval, staff will contact the organizations regarding appointment of their representatives.
