1.0 INTRODUCTION

A report was considered and approved during the Closed meeting of Council on 2020 November 09, at which Council adopted the following recommendations:

- 3. THAT correspondence be sent to BC Housing and Mosaic Homes advising on the selected non-profit housing operator.
