1.0 INTRODUCTION

For Council initiated local area services, Section 213(1)(a) of the Community Charter states that public notice must be provided compliant with Section 94 (*Public Notice*) and to the owners of parcels that would be subject to the local service tax. A notice has been published in the City newspaper on 2021 January 07 and 2021 January 14.

Further, Section 213(2)(c) of the Community Charter states:

"Council may proceed with establishing the service unless a petition against the service is presented within 30 days after notice has been given in accordance with this Section."
