REPORT

1.0 INTRODUCTION

This report is to seek Council approval for the Tommy Douglas Teen Space project in advance of council adoption of the 2021-2025 Provisional Financial Plan. In order to proceed with the award of contracts, funding approval is requested.

3.0 BACKGROUND

3.1 Tommy Douglas Teen Space (ADY.0020)

Estimated \$80,000

This project will renovate the Tommy Douglas Branch by converting the underused computer lab into a teen space and meeting growing patron demand for self-serve pick-up of requests.

These expenditures will be included in the 2021-2025 Provisional Financial Plan, and sufficient Capital Reserve Funds are available to finance the capital projects outlined in this report.

4.0 RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council authorize the City Solicitor to bring forward a Capital Reserve Fund Bylaw in the amount of \$80,000 to finance the project outlined in this report.
