### INTRODUCTION

The 2021 – 2025 Financial Plan provides funding for various multi-year capital improvement projects. In order to proceed with design and construction, funding approval is requested for the project listed below.

### 1.0 Infrastructure

## 1.1 Lougheed Highway Upgrade Austin to Underhill

Estimated \$300,000

This project will deliver road improvements on Lougheed Highway, between Austin Avenue to Underhill Avenue, which will provide urban trails and street beautification to improve the flow of vehicle traffic, and improve bicycle and pedestrian accessibility and safety.

The contractor has completed all of its work from Underhill Avenue to Gaglardi Way and the remaining work from Gaglardi Way to Austin Avenue is scheduled for completion by the end of this year.

Funding in the amount of \$12.9 million has been raised previously. The \$300,000 of funding requested in this report is specifically designated for additional electrical work, construction and inspection services and project overhead relating to the illuminated street name signs at each intersection along Lougheed Highway between Production Way and Austin Avenue, as well as extended communication conduits.
