REPORT

INTRODUCTION

Each year, the City of Burnaby presents the Kushiro Cup to its Outstanding Citizen of the Year. The Cup was presented to the City of Burnaby by its Sister City, Kushiro, Japan, in 1982.

A call for nominations for Burnaby's 2021 Outstanding Citizen of the Year award was made in January through advertisements in the Burnaby Now newspaper, the City's website, Twitter account and Facebook page, and direct emails to City employees and non-profit agencies.

The Executive Committee of Council, at its Closed meeting held on 2022 March 01, received and reviewed nominations that were submitted by community members, and recommended Mary Gates as the Kushiro Cup recipient and 2021 Outstanding Citizen of the Year.

Council, at its Closed meeting of 2022 March 07, adopted the recommendations of the Executive Committee and recommended Mary Gates as the 2021 Outstanding Citizen of the Year. This report is provided for public information.

2021 OUTSTANDING CITIZEN OF THE YEAR

Mary Gates has been chosen as the Kushiro Cup recipient and 2021 Outstanding Citizen of the Year for her kind approach to community building and inclusion.

Mary has been the Chair of the District 4 (Southwest) Community Policing Advisory Committee since 2013 where she leads the committee in addressing key public safety concerns. In addition, Mary is a member of Burnaby Citizens Crime Watch, a volunteer at the Southwest Community Police Office, and a Block Watch Co-Captain. But Mary's outreach extends much farther than the public safety of her community. Mary also finds time to volunteer with Girl Guides of Canada, where she has been leading and mentoring for over 30 years.

Mary's nominees note that she is a natural leader, who has made community volunteerism her lifestyle and is constantly striving to make the world a better place. To quote from Mary's nominator, "Mary Gates is a testament to the sentiment best described by Plato many centuries ago; "This city is what it is because our citizens are what they are."
