## <u>REPORT</u>

#### INTRODUCTION

The Executive Committee of Council, at its meeting held on 2023 February 01, considered Festivals Burnaby grant applications from community groups organizing neighbourhood, small scale, and large scale festivals in Burnaby.

#### POLICY

The provision of Festivals Burnaby grants to community groups is aligned with the following Council-adopted policies, plans, and strategies: Burnaby Economic Development Strategy (2007); Social Sustainability Strategy (2011), and the Corporate Strategic Plan (2017) that identifies the importance of a sense of belonging, inclusion, and high quality of life.
