PURPOSE: To provide Committee with information regarding a Festivals Burnaby

Grant application received and to seek Council approval of a grant.

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the following Large Scale Event Festivals Burnaby Grant be approved:

 23-L-013 – The North America Artist Association \$_____ for their 7th Burnaby Spring Festival Gala on January 6, 2024.

1.0 POLICY SECTION

The provision of Festivals Burnaby Grants is aligned with the following Council-adopted policies, plans and strategies: *Burnaby Economic Development Strategy* (2007); *Social Sustainability Strategy* (2011), the Benefits Based Approach (2023) and the *Corporate Strategic Plan* (2017) that identifies the importance of a sense of belonging, inclusion and high quality of life.

2.0 BACKGROUND

Festivals and special events make our community vibrant, strengthen our sense of pride and belonging and draw both local audiences and visitors. They are an important part of Burnaby's cultural resources framework. The City's annual Festivals Burnaby Grants budget for 2023 is \$250,000. The grant funds are vital to support cultural groups as they plan special events and recover from the COVID-19 pandemic.

The application has been completed in full, reviewed by staff, and the applicants have shown evidence that they have capacity to deliver the event. Festivals Burnaby Grants would be allocated toward eligible project expenses related to programming, venue and equipment, marketing/promotions and administration.

A Festivals Burnaby Grant application for Large Scale Events is being presented for consideration of the Committee to recommend approval by Council. The eligible request in this report is \$14,850. The balance available in this year's Festivals Burnaby Grants budget is \$60,200.

An application request for \$14,850 eligible amount has been received from the North America Artist Association for the 7th Burnaby Spring Festival Gala to be held on January 6, 2024 at the Michael J. Fox Theatre. The event is expected to attract approximately 500 people.

The multicultural art event will be held in celebration of the Chinese Lunar New Year. It will showcase diverse artistic performances, including music, dance and acrobatics and provides a platform for emerging and established artists to showcase their talent. The one-day event aims to foster a sense of community and appreciation of multiculturalism in Burnaby and hopes to attract a diverse audience made up of local residents of all ages, art lovers and commercial enterprises.

Grant funds will support artists/performers fees, venue/equipment rental and publicity/promotion. Other revenues are pending from corporate funding and low cost ticket sales for the event.

The North America Artist Association was established in 2016 as a non-profit with a mission to unite and promote diversified artistic exchanges and development among North American artistic elites of all ethnicities. It has held the Burnaby Spring Festival Gala for six consecutive years in celebration of Chinese New Year.

4.0 COMMUNICATION AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

All individuals and organizations receiving funding from the Festivals Burnaby Grants Program must acknowledge the support in all promotional materials with the Festivals Burnaby Grants Program logo.

5.0 FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The City's annual Festivals Grants budget for 2023 is \$250,000 and is funded through the Gaming Reserve. The following table provides a financial summary of the grant program to date. There is sufficient funding available, should all eligible requests included in this report be approved by Committee and Council.

The second intake for small and large scale applications is October 15, 2023 for festivals and special events taking place in January through June 2024. As this application is time sensitive with the festival scheduled for early January 2024, we are bringing this forward for consideration within the 2023 budget. The other applications will be presented in the new year as they will take place later in the spring and within the 2024 allocated budget.

Project Proposal: 2024 Burnaby Spring Festival Gala

Why do you need funds?

The North American Artists Association seeks government funding to support the 2024 Burnaby Spring Festival Gala, a large-scale annual arts, culture and community celebration held at the Michael J Fox Theater in Burnaby for the sixth consecutive year. Funding is vital to cover the costs associated with event planning, marketing and performances to ensure the evening goes off without a hitch. These expenses include venue rental, artist fees, marketing materials, equipment rental, logistics and publicity for the Burnaby Hospital Foundation. Additionally, funding will allow us to improve the artistic standards of the evening and attract a wider audience.

Target audience:

The main target audiences of the 2024 Burnaby Spring Festival Gala include Burnaby's commercial enterprises, social groups, local residents of all ages, and art lovers. Our goal is to create an inclusive and diverse environment that welcomes everyone, not just the Chinese celebrating traditional festivals, but also artists, performers and audiences from other ethnic groups.
