# 1.0 POLICY SECTION

The proposal outlined in the report aligns with the goals and values in the Corporate Strategic Plan (2017), and the City of Burnaby's purpose to create a city that we all want to live, work, and play in.

#### 2.0 BACKGROUND

The City of Burnaby has had a long standing relationship with the Burnaby Christmas Bureau. Since 2011, ticket sales from 5:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. on the Bright in Burnaby seasonal tree lighting event, have been donated to the Burnaby Christmas Bureau program, with Concord Pacific, the Heritage Christmas presenting sponsor matching the donations. In 2019, sale of rides totaled \$2,260.44. In 2020 the Burnaby Village Museum (BVM) was closed due to COVID-19. In 2021, sale of rides totaled \$1,083,60. Last year, as the Carousel was in need of repairs, the sale of cookies and cocoa from the Ice Cream Parlour between 5:00 p.m.– 9:00 p.m. on December 2, 2022 were donated in the amount of \$2,177.50.

#### 3.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

The BVM is presenting Heritage Christmas from November 25, 2023 to January 5, 2024 (closed December 24 and 25). As the Carousel is operational this year, <u>attached</u> is a request (Attachment 1) from the Burnaby Christmas Bureau seeking PRC Commission approval for the donation of Carousel ticket sales on December 2, 2023 from 5:00 –

Carousel ticket sales over the past several years for this event have varied. In 2019, it was \$2,260.44, in 2020 the BVM was closed due to COVID-19 and in 2021 it was \$1,083.60. It is estimated that for 2023 ride sales will be approximately \$2,000.
