

Monday, March 4, 1957

A Public Hearing was held in the Council Chamber, 4000 Grandview Highway, on Monday, March 4, 1957 at 7.15 p.m.

Present: Reeve MacSorley in the Chair; Crs. W.P.Philps, Hean, Hughes, Morrison F.Philps, and Brown.

The following ^{rezoning} applications were considered:

- (1) All that area bounded by Sperling Avenue on the west, Union Street on the south, Duncan Avenue on the east, and the North boundary of Lot 1, S.J."A", Blk.4, J.L.206 and Frances Street on the north,

From Light Industrial to Residential two Family.

- (2) (a) Lot 19, S.J.14, Blk.1, J.L.120
- (b) Lot 22, S.J.13, Blk.1, J.L.120.
- (c) Lot "B" R.S.).19, S.J.15, Blk.1, J.L.120

from Commercial to Residential Multiple family type 1.

No one appeared in opposition to the proposed rezonings on either application.
