Uniforms, more steel helmets, more equipment have been sent to us. Orders have been received to step up Warden training and to make it uniform so as to follow a definite plan.

In this regards, our own Provincial A.R.P. Officer, Inspector S.F.M. Moodie was called back East to act as Chairman of a committee authorized to draw up a programme of Warden training for the whole Dominion. Several Burnaby ideas were brought forward by our good friend the Inspector and were very favourably commented upon and adopted.

In the meantime the Controller, Division Directors and Division Wardens have given our Warden training programme a lot of thought as will be seen by the syllabus and schedule contained in this issue.

At least three District meetings a month are called for, and one Division Social a month at which, as an item on the programme, teams from other Divisions will come over and compete in Quizz contests etc. This getting together is one of the finest things we can do to keep up interest. We have found that out in the very successful Incident Control class, which was held this summer, and the Bomb Reconnaissance class just finished.

The East and the West have met, and the North and the South are no more divided. Burnaby Civil Defence is ONE.

Amending Routine Order 109, Sept. 30/43. Length of service chevron will be worn on the lower left sleeve, point upwards, centre of lowest chevron to be 5" from edge of cuff.

For all personnel enrolled between September 3, 1939 and December 1, 1941 - 1 green chevron.

At the commencement of each succeeding year of service - 1 orange chevron
