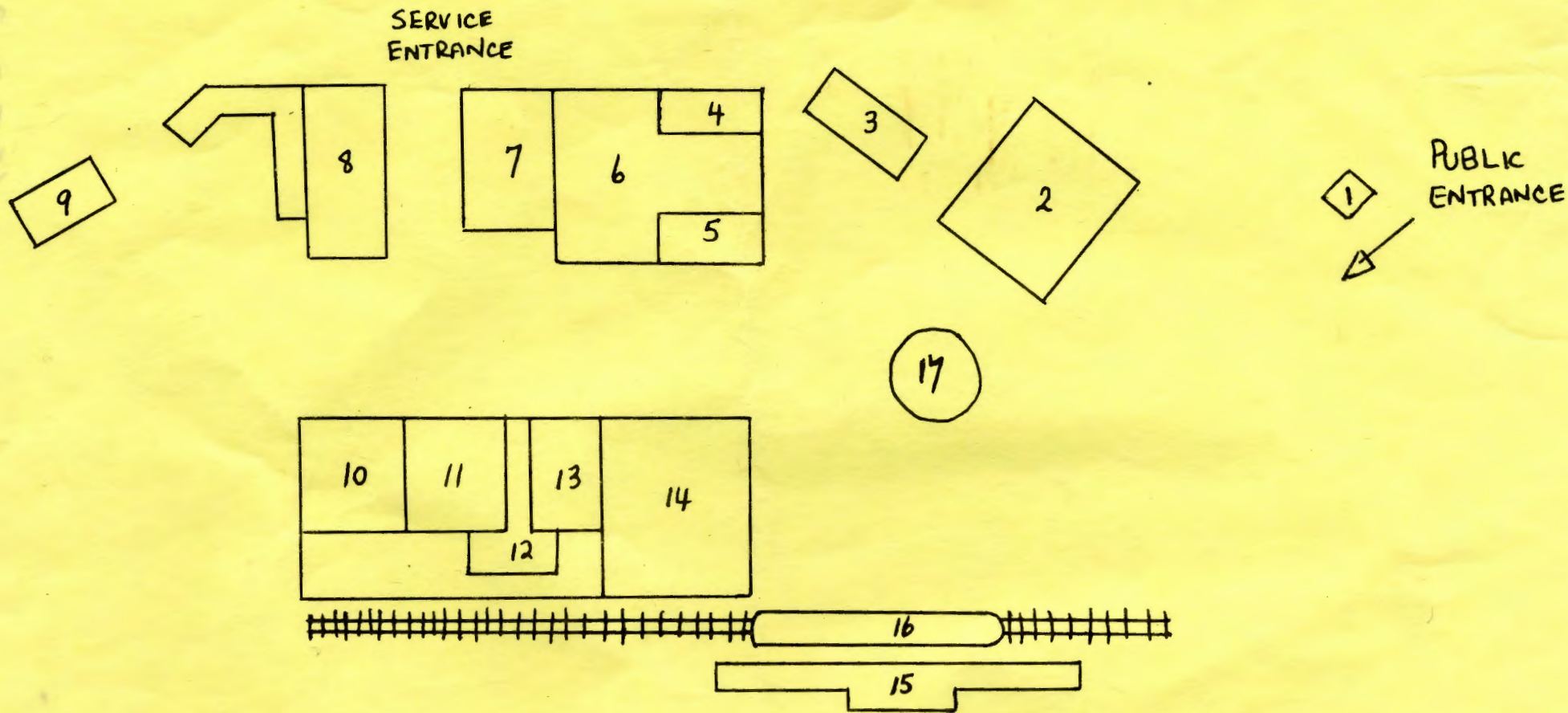
The other members of the Executive Committee and the Board of Directors join with me in extending to you and yours our sincere best wishes for a healthy and prosperous 1973 and succeeding years.
