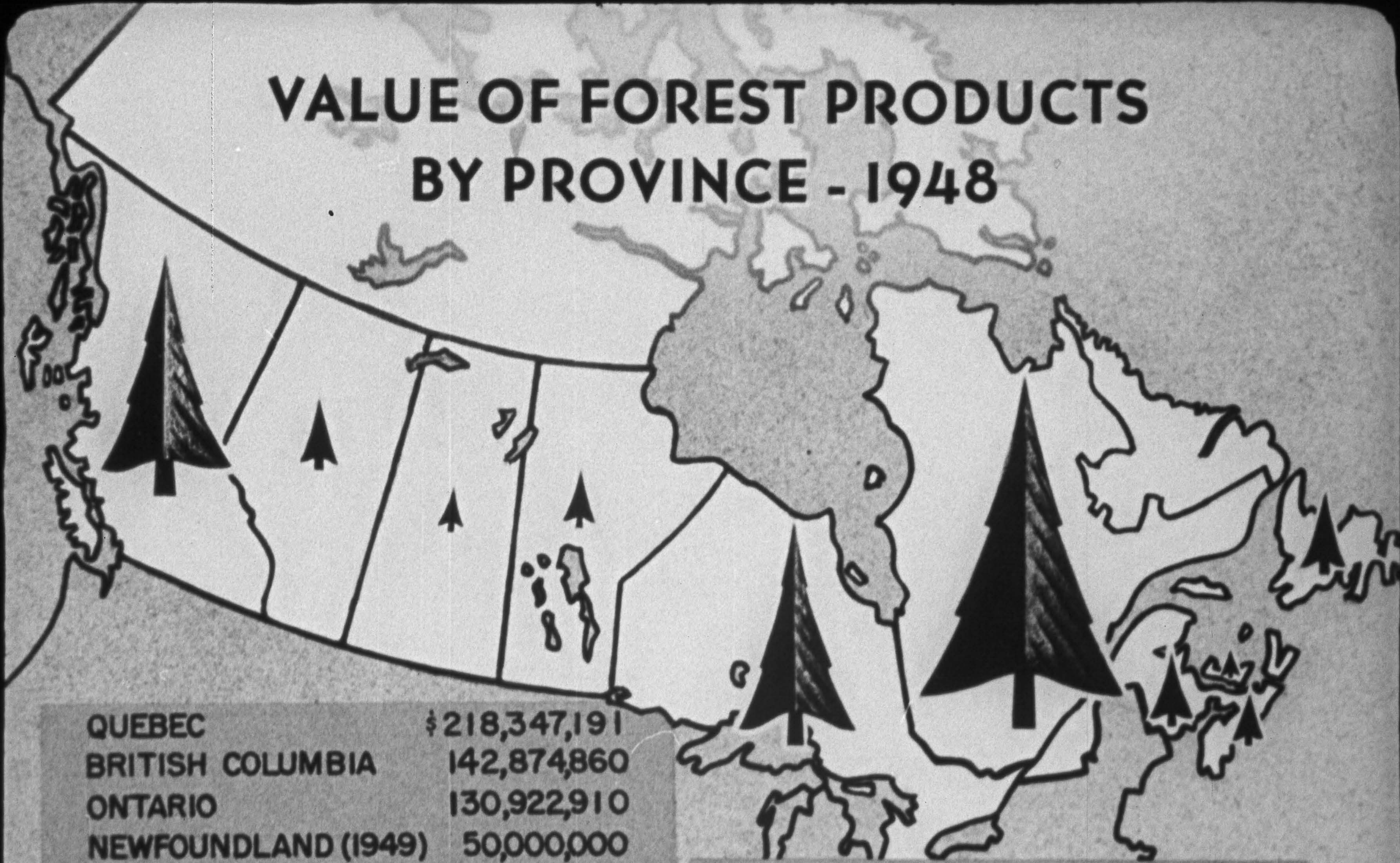

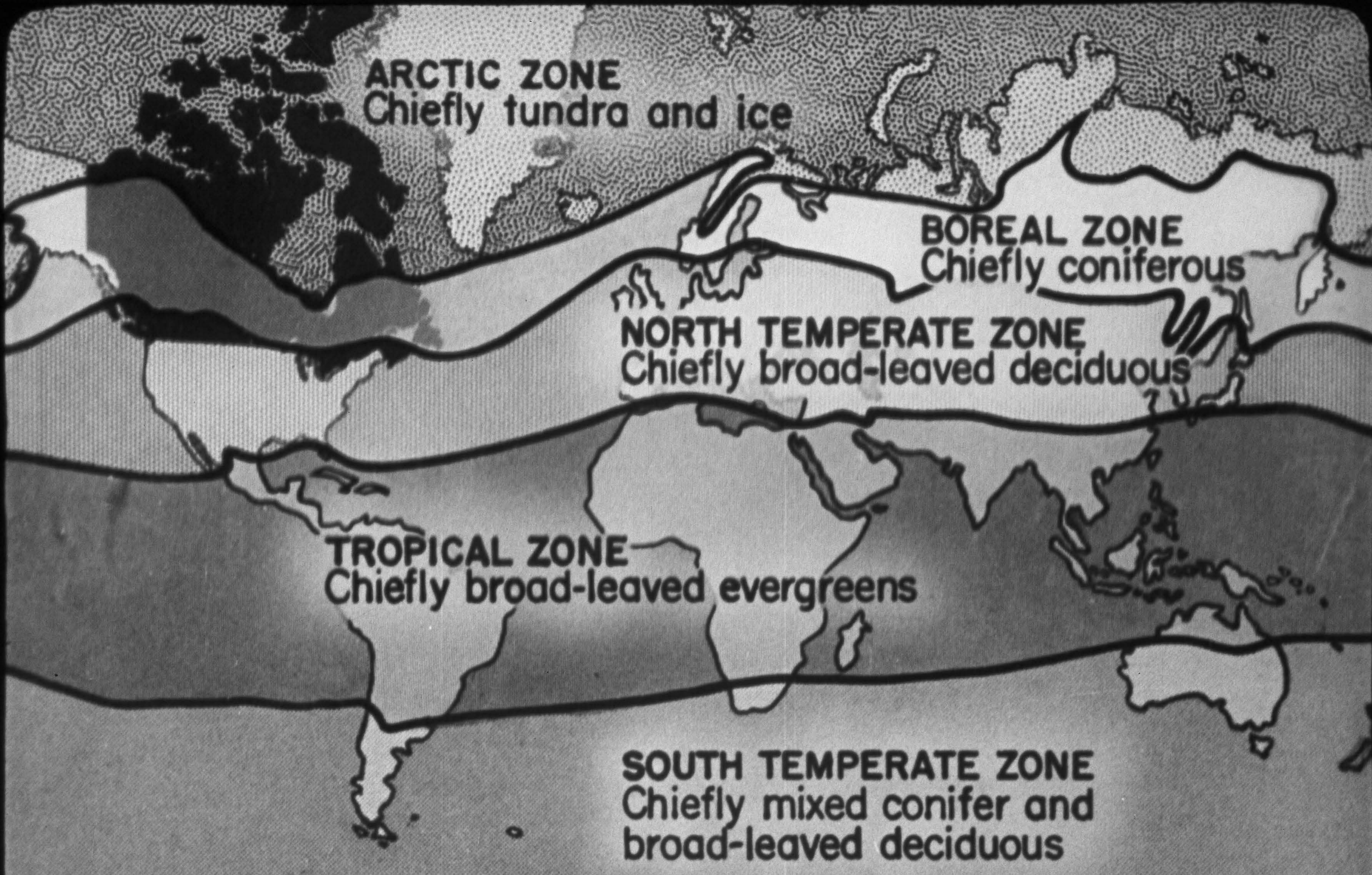

Chiefly broad-leaved deciduous

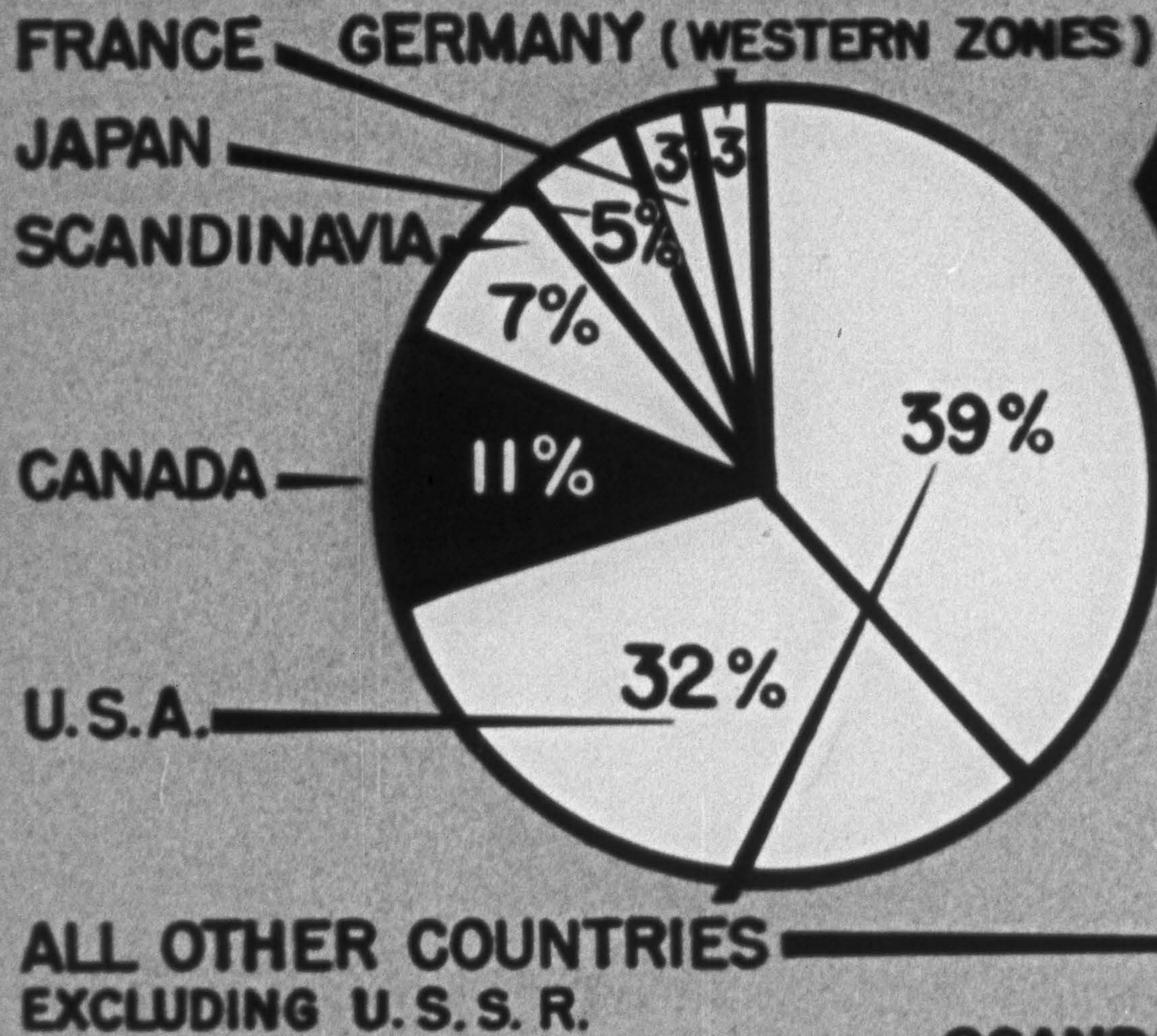
TROPICAL ZONE

broad-leaved deciduous

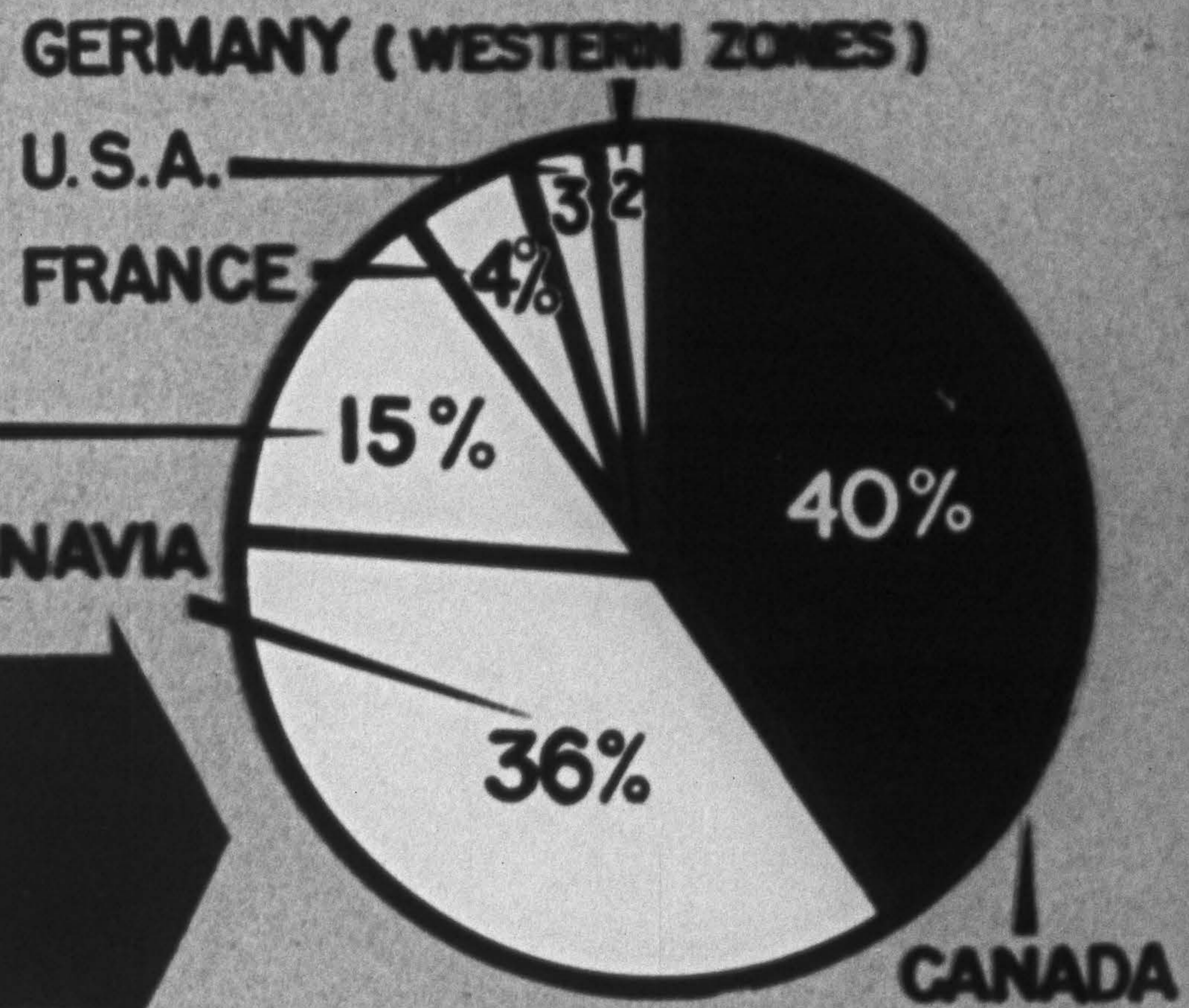
