

By-law No. 106.

A By-law for the Regulation of Bowling Alleys and Pool Rooms.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows :

- 1- All bowling alleys and all pool rooms within the limits of the Municipality of Burnaby wherein billiard or pool tables are kept for hire or profit shall be closed on Sunday during the whole twenty-four hours and on other days from midnight until 6 o'clock in the morning.
- 2- All bowling alleys and pool rooms shall be subject to the supervision of the Chief of Police of the Municipality, and the Chief of Police and Constables of the said Municipality shall have access to the same at all times.
- 3- No gambling or betting of any kind or description shall be permitted in any bowling alley or pool room within the Municipality. - Municipality and printed notices to that effect shall be displayed on the walls in all such bowling alleys and pool rooms.
- 4- Youths under the age of sixteen years shall not be allowed in any bowling alley or pool room within the Municipality.
- 5- Any violation or breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall subject the licensee of such bowling alley or pool room upon conviction to a fine not exceeding ~~One hundred~~ dollars together with costs and in default of payment to imprisonment not exceeding three months.
- 6- This by-law may be cited cited as , - "BOWLING ALLEYS AND POOL ROOM REGULATION BY-LAW 1911"
