By-law No. 104, (107)

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows :

1. No person shall post any indecent placards, writings or pictures or write indecent words or make indecent pictures or drawings on any walls, fences, trees or rocks in any streets, highways or public places in the Municipality.
2. No person shall use any profane swearing, obscene, blasphemous or grossly insulting language or be guilty of any other immorality or indecency within the Municipality.
3. No person shall be guilty of drunkenness or any disorderly conduct in any street highway or public place in the Municipality.
4. Any person guilty of an infraction of this by-law shall be liable upon summary conviction to a fine not exceeding the sum of \$100.00 together with costs, and in default of payment to imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.
5. This by-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Public Morals By-law 1911"
