By-Law No. 109

<u>A BY-LAW</u>, to provide for the raising of Revenue for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby in District Lot 172 (extra municipal).

WHEREAS, by the Public Schools Act 1905, Amendment Act 1906, the Council of any City, Town or Rural Municipality in the Province are empowered in each and every year to pass a By-Law or By-Laws for levying a special rate of not more than five (5) mills on the dollar for school purposes in addition to what is required for the payment of interest and Sinking Fund on any debt of the Municipality created for school purposes.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Public Instruction are empowered under the said Public Schools Act to create new School Districts in addition to those already in existence and to define the boundaries of existing districts from time to time and to cancel the creation of school districts.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Public Instruction by an order dated the 14th, of March 1906 included in the boundaries of Burnaby Municipality for School purposes the whole of District Lot 172.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Clauses Act and the Public Schools Act 1905, Amendment Act 1906.

for the year 1911 upon the assessed value of all wild and improved taxable real property in District Lot 172 as shewn upon the last revised Assessment Roll thereof all improvements being exempt altogether a tax of eighty nine one hundredths mills on the Dollars for the following purposes:-


- (a) TO PROVIDE for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby Sixty three one hundredths mills on the dollar to be called the " School Rate."
- (b) TO PROVIDE for interest and sinking fund on One hundred and thirteen thousand five hundred Dollars (\$113,500.) School Debentures issued by the Municipality twenty six one hundredths Mills on the Dollar to be called the " School Loan Rate."
- THE SAID TAXES shall be payable at the Municipal 2. Hall, Burnaby on or before the 31st. day of August 1911.

THIS BY-LAW may be cited for all purposes as the " Burnaby School Board (Extra Municipal) Revenue By-Law 1911." PASSED by the Council on the Third day of July , 1911.
