for preventing or regulating the use of Guns or other Firearms within the Municipality of Burnaby.

The Municipal Council of the The Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows :-

Rifles

1. No person shall fire or discharge any Rifle or other fire-arm carrying ball-cartridge within the limits of the Municipality of Burnaby without a permit to be previously obtained from the Chief of Police of the Municipality.

Shooting across Highway

2. No person shall fire or discharge any Gun, Fowling-piece or fire-arm on or across any Public Road or Highway within the limits of the Municipality of Burnaby.

Boys under 16 years not allowed

3. No person being under the age of 16 years shall use, carry or be in possession of any Gun, Fowling-piece or fire-arm within the limits of the said Municipality.

4. No person shall on a Sunday fire or discharge any Gun, Fowling-piece, or other Fire-arm within the limits of the said Municipality.

Penalty

5. Any person guilty of an infraction of this by-law shall, upon conviction thereof, before the Reeve, Police Magistrate, or any Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction within the said Municipality, be liable at the discretion of the said Reeve, Police Magistrate, Justice of the Peace convicting as aforesaid to a penalty not exceeding \$100.00 together with the costs of the prosecution and in default of payment forthwith, it shall be lawful for the Reeve, Police Magistrate, or Justice of the Peace convicting as aforesaid to issue a Warrant under his hand and seal to levy the said Penalty and costs by distress and sale of the offender's goods and chattels and in default of such distress it shall and may be lawful for the Reeve, Police Magistrate or Justice convicting as aforesaid to commit the offender to prison for any period not exceeding 30 days with or without Hard Labour.
